

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
# % of Annual Fund Allocated to Children's Issues?

## What is being funded?

- School based mental health services
- School based health centers
- Early childhood programs
- Technical assistance and training
- Universal school based prevention programs
- Social/emotional learning programs
- Public policy and advocacy



### What lessons have been learned?

- Most often cited was the challenges faced when working in schools
  - Integration into school environment
  - Need for buy-in from leadership and staff
  - Need for flexibility
  - Acknowledge differences in providers from different fields



### More Lessons....

- Evaluation is important
  - Difficulty with tying outcomes to interventions
- Sustainability
  - Need funds over several years before meaningful change is seen
  - "don't pay it all, it won't be sustained"
  - "don't isolate funding for the very emotionally troubled part of the student spectrum"
  - Billing is critical "hard to run forever on grants/charitable gifts"



### What advice do they have to offer?

- "takes a lot of social and financial capital to do it well"
- Include policy and evaluation from the start
- Get school buy in and clarity of focus from the beginning
- Ongoing support, technical assistance and learning opportunities are important to success
- Don't just fund services without investing in sustainability
- Make sure outside organizations understand the complexity of working in the school environment
