

DOUBLE UP Impact for Customers

93% of SNAP customers report eating more fruits and vegetables.

83% report buying fewer low-nutrition/high fat snacks





DOUBLE UP Health Impact Evaluation

Multi-year health impact evaluation will:

- Provide the first in-depth analysis of a SNAP incentive program users and associated health impacts.
- Evaluate the effect of Double Up on fruit and vegetable purchase and consumption.
- Determine specific barriers to and facilitators of program use, increased fruit and vegetable purchase and consumption, etc.
- Develop a community-informed, clinic-based intervention and evaluate impact on disease management and prevention.



DOUBLE UP Health Impact Evaluation




Initial Findings:

- Surveyed SNAP shoppers are overwhelmingly appreciative of the program.
- Double Up supported intentional shifts to more healthful diet.
- Farmers markets valued as community and health resource.


Michigan Farmers Markets Combined SNAP & Double Up Sales Growth

National cluster evaluation found significant economic and health impacts of incentive programs.



CLUSTER EVALUATION



The 75 Double Up markets in Michigan made up just 14% of total markets surveyed, but accounted for more than half of all **SNAP** incentive dollars spent.






 Healthy food incentives can help transform a community's food environment and improve health outcomes.
