

- Care across the lifespan


Nurses can help address these needs

Recommendations

Seek significant improvement in public and institutional policies at national, state and local levels

The Future of Nursing Report



A blueprint to:

- Ensure that nurses can practice to full extent of their education and training
- Improve nursing education
- Provide opportunities for nurses to assume leadership positions and to serve as full partners in health care redesign and improvement efforts
- Improve data collection for workforce planning and policy-making
- Foster interprofessional collaboration






Campaign Vision

- Field strategy to move key nursing issues forward at local, state and national levels
- Pilot in 15 states before moving nationwide
- Capture best practices, track lessons learned and identify replicable models
