#### **DIRECTIONS:**

The Atlantic Philanthropies office is located at the intersection of Varick and Canal Streets. The main entrance is about 100 yards north of Canal Street on the west side of Varick Street opposite the intersection of Varick Street with Grand Street. The building is also called **One Hudson Square**. The cross-street to the north of the building is Watts Street; the next cross-street to the north is Broome Street; if you get to either of them walking north, you've gone too far!

### By Subway:

Take the 1 (Seventh Avenue local) to the Canal Street stop, which leaves you at the corner of Canal and Varick Streets. If you take the 2 or 3 (Seventh Avenue Express), transfer to the 1 at 14<sup>th</sup> Street (heading downtown) or at Chambers Street (heading uptown). You can also take the A, C, or E (Eighth Avenue subway) to the Canal Street stop; this leaves you at the corner of Sixth Avenue and Canal Street. Walk one block west to Varick Street and 100 yards north to the main entrance.

# **Getting into the City from the Airports**

## By Taxi

Once you arrive, the easiest option is to hop into a cab. Each airport has a taxi stand with uniformed dispatchers, and lines tend to move quickly. Fares do not include tolls and tips. From *La Guardia* to Downtown, expect to pay \$30–\$35. For trips between (to and from) Manhattan and *JFK International Airport*, the flat fare is \$45.00 plus any tolls using Rate Codes on the meter. From *Newark*, you cannot get a New York yellow cab; the dispatcher will give you a written slip with the fare based on your destination. It'll usually run \$40 to \$45.
